Narrative:

At 5:15PM, Randy McMurray, Hazmat Supervisor, notified me that oil clumps were reported onshore at a beach in Pacific Grove. At 5:30PM, I contacted the reporting party, Kathy Halliburton, who observed the oil on rocks on the beach on May 5th. She described it as oil patties and decided to report the observation now after a news report of an oil slick observed in the bay. She thought it might be related.

I was onsite at parking lot #5 on Ocean Ave in Pacific Grove at 6:00PM and check the adjacent beach and the next beach south of the location. I did not see or smell oil or tar. It was windy, the water was choppy, and the tide was approximately 3ft and rising. There was no observation of oil or sheen in the pools of water or trapped in the sand.
