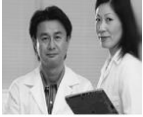

Free Services

Each month CWES pays for expenses that can make going to work, school or training hard. Over a year the potential savings can really add up!

Free Help

Feeling confused, stressed, depressed, or anxious? Are drugs and alcohol taking control of or causing problems in your life? CWES provides free referrals and access to services to help you.



- **Behavioral Health Counseling** - Individual and group sessions to help you and your family navigate life's stresses and help you reach your full potential.
- **Child Support Services** - Assistance with Child Support Order modifications and California Driver's License releases.
- **Domestic Violence Social Workers** - Education and information about domestic violence and safety planning. Referrals to services such as restraining orders, counseling, and safe housing.
- **Family Stabilization Services** - Short-term intensive case management services to remove barriers when you are experiencing an identified crisis that is destabilizing your family.
- **Legal Services** - To help you through criminal record expungement, identity theft and credit repair, background checks, and driver's license issues.
- **Learning Needs Evaluations** - To find out the accommodations or support you may need to be successful in work and school.
