Narrative: I received a call from County Communications regarding a sewage spill at Carmel-by-the-Sea. I called Capt. Neil Hurd from Monterey Fire Dept., he indicated that the sewage spill had been contained and did not make it the storm drain. I arrived on scene and reported to IC Capt. Hurd, he showed the spill came from Pangaea Grill restaurant's cleanout line and that the spill had stopped an been contained before it made it to a storm drain. I was informed the restaurant's plumber was already on the way to clear their lateral line. The plumber arrived, snaked the lateral line and pulled a rag/hand towel that caused the blockage in the sewage line. I had the restaurant employees mop and sanitize the sidewalk and their curb area for outdoor dining. I cleared the scene at 4:00 PM.
