**Narrative:** I received a call from County Communications about a vehicle fire at Old Stage Road near Zabala Road in Salinas. I called Sergeant Christopher Holm from CHP, he indicated that the car was a stolen car left on the side of the road that caught on fire. I arrived on scene, the car fire was already put out by Fire Department and towed away. The soil was wet from dousing the fire with 600 gallons of water and biodegradable foam. Sgt. Holm estimated about less than 10 gallons of the car's gasoline were released on the soil that was dripping from the vehicle while on fire. I called Monterey County Public Works to assist with the cleanup, they stated they will take care of the gasoline spill first thing on Monday morning. I cleared the scene at 12:15 PM.
