Narrative: At approximately 4:30pm Senior Inspector, Robert Fernandez, informed me that there had been an ammonia release at BC Systems/Fresh Express. Robert Fernandez had been notified by Juan Hernandez who is the Maintenance Manager at the facility. Juan Hernandez explained the incident to Robert Fernandez and informed him that the ammonia system is currently locked down and the area has been isolated.

I arrived on scene at approximately 6pm and met Juan Hernandez and Trinidad Ramirez who is the Compliance Safety Manager for the facility. Trinidad explained to me that a pallet had hit and damaged an evaporative coil in the vacuum cooling tube which caused an ammonia release. The release was observed immediately and radioed in. The area was immediately evacuated and isolated. Mr. Ramirez stated that the system is currently locked out and will remain locked out until Kemper Refrigeration repairs the damaged evaporative coil. Kemper Refrigeration is scheduled to conduct the repairs on 6/25/2021. I explained to Mr. Ramirez that the CUPA's CalARP Inspector for Monterey County, Robert Fernandez, will be conducting a more detailed inspection on 6/25/2021 as well.
