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Narrative: I received a page from County Communications regarding a kitchen fire at the Carmel Valley Ranch Resort. I responded and met with the Director of Culinary F & B Operations (Ritchard Cariaga). Mr. Cariaga showed me the affected machinery and the area with the dry chemical powder as well as the two portable dry chem fire extinguishers. No evacuation was necessary. The grill is out-of-service until cleaned and then reconnected to the gas utility. Mr. Cariaga's kitchen crew cleaned and disinfected the food preparations surfaces near the area. Monterey Regional Fire Department indicated that a follow-up will be conducted on Monday, August 2. I indicated that the Monterey County Health Department Consumer Protection Office in Monterey may follow-up via phone or site visit.
