- 7. Quality assurance: To confirm repairs have been completed per standards, we conduct a final inspection.

### Lead Mitigation Program (LMP)

Our goal is to prevent, reduce or eliminate Lead hazards from homes. We help tenants and property owners by providing free services to remove lead paint hazards from your **pre—1978** home.

You qualify if your home was built **before 1978** and you can answer yes to any of these conditions:

- $\Rightarrow$  Do you have cracked, chipped, or peeling paint?
- $\Rightarrow$  Is there a child under 6 years old living in or frequently visiting your home?
- $\Rightarrow$  Is anyone living in your home pregnant?
- $\Rightarrow$  Are you considered low income?

### Who can apply ?

All tenants, landlords or property

owners are eligible to apply.

# What do you need to do?

- 1. Fill out an application: An application is accepted via email, phone, or online at www.mtyhd.org/LLMP
- 2. Wait for evaluation of eligibility: If your home is eligible, we will inform you in writing.
- 3. Lead hazard evaluation: You will allow a lead hazard inspection in your home.
- 4. Permit to entry: All property owners must permit entry of an inspector and contractors to work in the home.
- 5. Schedule repairs: We will work with you and your family to schedule repairs by our certified contractors at no cost to you.
