VIDEO CONFERENCE WITH EHB

Members of the EHB Land Use team are available to answer questions and concerns that fellow County employees and the public have about land use and onsite wastewater regulations. Our workstations have each been equipped with ZOOM to video conference with you from a remote location.

EXAMPLES OF QUESTIONS WE CAN ANSWER ON THE SPOT

- Does EHB need to review this type of application?
- Does this property have an onsite wastewater treatment (OWTS, or septic system)?
 - ✓ Please complete the EHB's File Review Request form to be furnished a copy of available records during/after the ZOOM session.
- Would this be considered a bedroom for purposes of OWTS evaluation?

COMPREHENSIVE DEVELOPMENT CONCEPTS MAY TAKE MORE TIME

Concept consultations are limited to 15-30 minutes. If you want or need more time with a Land Use team member to consider water, wastewater or other EHB-related impacts, please submit a <u>Request for Service</u> (subject to cost recovery fees associated with staff time to conduct research and confer with you).

REQUEST COPIES OF EHB RECORDS

Having a copy of property records in-hand helps to make the most of a conversation with our team. A <u>File Review Request form</u> may be submitted online, at the front counter of the EHB, or by fax to (831) 755-4880. The EHB Office Support team will provide the records as soon as possible, but it can take up to 10 business days to prepare and provide them.
