# **JOB-HOUSING NEXUS ANALYSIS**

- Existing burden of affordable housing is on residential development
- Should Non-residential Developments contribute to affordable housing development through commercial linkage fees?
- Non-residential linkage fee is consistent with Housing Element Policy
