Notice is hereby given that the County of Monterey is seeking written comment on the Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) on the Mid Valley Shopping Center Project (PLN190140, SCH#2020090480) in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act. The public review period will begin on November 24, 2021 and end on January 10, 2022. This review period is established for the purpose of receiving written comments on the accuracy and adequacy of the DEIR together with other information relative to the environmental effect of the project.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Facade upgrades and site improvements at the Mid-Valley Shopping Center: upgrades include new paint / change of color around the window trims and roof fascia; veneer wood siding over existing aggregate columns; the removal of the "breezeway" or overhead roof element connecting Building A and Building C; and open up 8 roof areas on Buildings A, B & C to provide better visibility of the tenant spaces. The major components of the roof structure would remain. The roof areas at 6 corners would be removed exposing the fascia and joists and substituting a bronzed aluminum decorative panel. The proposed colors include "earth-inspired soft light to medium colors." The project also includes replacement of the portions of the existing landscaping with drought-tolerant landscaping.
