i. Updates • Jason Cameron	 Per a communication with Erica Chaney, the Manager at CCCVC, Jason reported, due to lack of a Groundskeeper staff member the cemetery was experiencing trouble fulfilling inground burial services. He added that the Military and Veterans Affairs Office provided support by reaching out to other cemeteries, businesses, organizations, and community members to assist the cemetery by either volunteering or encouraging those interested to apply to the open Groundskeeper positions. Of the individuals that did apply only one met the minimum qualifications. Of the volunteers they were put in contact with, two have been at the cemetery assisting with installing headstones. For in-ground services a Cal Vet employee from the Igo cemetery has been coming once a week on Thursdays so they are able to do two services on that day.
	 The committee was also informed of the passing of Mark George. Mr. George was the Operations Manager of the Northern California Veterans Cemetery at Igo, who helped to oversee operations at CCVC, and was pivotal in getting to inground burial services operational at CCVC. Candy Ingram noted, "that he was wonderfully creative and very willing to get things done." He will be missed by all that knew him.
