- 2. Second violation, the amount of base fine shall be one hundred dollars (\$100) to two hundred dollars (\$200) per violation.*
- 3. Third violation, the amount of base fine shall be two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) to five hundred dollars (\$500) per violation.*
