1. CALL TO ORDER – Pledge of Allegiance

a. ALUC File No. REF220028 / City of Monterey

Proposed adoption of an amendment to Chapter 38-112.4, Personal Wireless Service Facilities, of the City of Monterey's Municipal Code Proposed Action: ALUC find the proposed amendment consistent with the 2019 Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan for Monterey Regional Airport.

Sabo commented that electrical interference is prohibited in all safety zones and Commissioner Cleveland agreed with Commissioner Sabo's comment.

Commissioner Delgado joined at 3:15pm.

Kim Cole commented on the wireless communication facility requires of the current and proposed wireless ordinance. Cole encourages the reliance on FAA and FCC guidelines. Cole explained the shot clock that limits the time frame of project review and approval. Commissioner Cleveland asked if there is an appeal process. Commissioner Delgado asked about the lifespan of the CUP and if the City can deny an application for height inconsistencies.

Proxy Godown asked if the resolution and the draft ordinance is consistent with the ALUCP and responds to the Airport staff's comments. ALUC staff confirmed.

Verizon representative explained FAA and FCC review. FAA is studying the effects of 5G on 50 airports within the US to determine the potential impacts. All wireless facilities will be required to comply with FAA and FCC standards. RF engineer explained the RF assessment.

The ALUC voted 6 to 0 (6 ayes – 0 nayes) to continue the item to the May 23, 2022, annual ALUC meeting. Motion made by Commissioner Cleveland and seconded by Proxy Godown.

b. ALUC File No. REF220026 / Verizon

Proposed replacement of six wireless 4G antennas with six wireless 5G antennas and associated equipment improvements. Proposed Action: ALUC find the proposed project consistent with the 2019 Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan for Monterey Regional Airport.

ALUC staff (Jensen) presented the project.

The ALUC voted 6 to 0 (6 ayes – 0 nayes) to approve the proposed project with one change. Commissioner Cleveland made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Proxy Godown, to approve the project with one change to ALUC-9 condition; add the following language to requirement #1 of the condition, "...and receipt of a Determination of No Hazard response from the FAA;..."

Proposed replacement of three wireless 4G antennas with three wireless 5G antennas and associated equipment improvements. Proposed Action: ALUC find the proposed project consistent with the 2019 Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan for Monterey Regional Airport.

ALUC staff (Jensen) presented the project.
