The overview of the Special Events Task Force is to form a partnership between event planners and regulatory agency staff to provide support addressing life, health, and safety issues. The purpose of this meeting is to guide event organizers through the County permit process and to familiarize them with agency staff who will be their points of contact, and to have an open discussion with stakeholders on any concerns regarding an event.

 - Event will have about 80 participants.
 - Will take place within the park boundaries.
 - No permits needed from HCD.
 - Event will take place on May 1, 2022.
 - Event time is from 8:00a.m. to 2:00p.m.
 - No signage on the county right of way.
 - Park rangers will be on site
 - Event organizers have signed the agreement and paid all fees.

 - If permits come submitted less than 60 days of the event there are additional fees.
 - Additional fees are 1 ½ times the standard permit fees.
 - If permits come in less than 30 days to the event.
 - Additional fees are twice the standard permit fees.
 - Requestor has not contact Josh to set up inspections for inspectors to walk the course.
 - Inspections will be scheduled once permits have been issued.

 - Salinas
 - Gonzales
 - Greenfield
- Will travel southbound on Halon Road connecting to Highway 101 traveling through Bradley and exiting Monterey County when cyclist enter Camp Roberts.
- Cyclist will travel stager following all rules of the road.
- No road closures will be need necessary since cyclist will be utilizing the bike lane.
- There will be the following aids provided to riders:
 - Sweep vehicles to assist participants between rest stops.
 - Caboose that will follow the last cyclist.
 - Sag buses at rest tops to transport cyclist back to campsite if cyclist cannot continue with the race.
 - Volunteer Course Marshalls to guide cyclist through difficult intersections.
- Currently working with supervisor Chris Lopez to arrange alternative rest stop location, since Mission Soledad will not be used this year.
