FORM – GS

The following conditions shall be a part of Encroachment Permit # _____.

1. This permit is authorization for use within the public road right-of-way for parking vehicles, the temporary laying of cable and test recording equipment only.
2. No testing shall be conducted within the paved portion of the roadway or near any drainage, or other structure or facility.
3. All indentations and excavations shall be backfilled and compacted. No excavation shall be made unless approved by this Department prior to commencing work.
4. The road right-of-way shall be left in a neat, presentable condition.
5. The permittee shall indemnify and save harmless the County of Monterey, and all officers and employees thereof, from all suits, claims or legal actions of every name, kind and description brought forth as a result either directly or indirectly, of the work performed under this permit.
6. This permit is issued for work within the County road right-of-way only and does not imply trespass, encroachment, etc. onto privately owned property.
7. Under no circumstances shall this work interfere with public traffic or present a public safety problem. Proper signs and other devices pertaining to public safety shall be used at all times.
8. In lieu of fastening cable down with duct tape, the cable shall be taped to a ½" minimum nylon rope stretched taut across the roadway and the ends of the rope securely anchored on both side of the pavement clear of traffic. A BARRICADE SHALL BE PLACED OVER ANCHOR STAKE PLACED IN SHOULDER OF ROAD.
