ROCKEFELLER FOUNDATION FOR MONTEREY COUNTY

SALINAS, Sept. 7.—The Board of Supervisors has accepted the offer of Dr. P. W. Covington, representing the Rockefeller Foundation, and has appropriated \$5000 for the maintenance of a model county health department for the coming year, with the understanding that the Rockefeller Foundation will contribute a like amount. The \$5000 from the Rockefeller Foundation together with the county appropriation will provide for two county public health nurses, a health inspector, a stenographer and a county health officer who will devote his entire time to the work, drawing a salary of \$3000 a year.

The same proposition, as offered by Dr. Covington, has already been accepted by San Luis Obispo county, and Orange county is favorably considering it. It is to be given to only three counties in the state.
