





Steps in the Community Plan Update Process





What is a Community Plan?

- 1. Part of the Monterey County General Plan
- 2. Specific to Unincorporated Communities in the County
- 3. Prepared for Castroville in 2007 *not certified for coastal zone areas*



Purpose of the Community Plan Update

- Stimulate Housing and Economic Development
- Remove Areas in the Coastal Zone
- "Right Size" the Planning Area
- Simplify the Community Plan
- Complete Impact Fee Nexus Study
 - 12/6/22 Stay (stop) collection of Castroville Traffic Impact Fees




Key Issues/ Scope of Revisions

- Scale Impact Fees to Match




2007 Castroville Community Plan Boundaries and Coastal Zone




Merritt Street Opportunity Area – 2023 Plan






Examples of Mixed-Use Development






Opportunities for Infill and Intensification


