

CLAIM FOR VETERAN'S EXEMPTION OF BUSINESS LICENSE FEE

Section 16102 of the California Business and Professions Code allows every soldier, sailor, or marine of the United States, who has received an honorable discharge or release from active duty under honorable conditions from such service, to hawk, peddle, and vend any goods, wares or merchandise owned by him, (except spirituous, malt, vinous, or other intoxicating liquor), without payment of any license fee. The \$4 CA ADA fee and late fees are not waived.

This fee exemption is subject to annual review and approval. Please complete the application completely and accurately; incomplete applications will be returned. Mail this application and any supporting documents to the Treasurer-Tax Collector's Office at PO Box, 891, Salinas, CA 93902-0891.
