Topic

SB 24 authorizes a court to include in an ex parte order a a provision restraining a party from accessing records and information pertaining to the health care, education, daycare, recreational activities, or employment of a minor child of the parties. Monterey County Behavioral Health (MCBH) and its contracted providers will adhere to the law regarding protecting health information from a restrained party when that provision has been granted. The purpose of this protocol is to establish a procedure which will protect health information of beneficiaries who have obtained such an order and shall ensure that protected health information will not be released to the restrained party.

Procedure

- 1. A beneficiary and/or parent/guardian/authorized representative provides their case coordination with a signed Restraining Order with provision, stating that health information shall not be shared with the restrained party.
- The case coordinator will review the order and confirm that the contact information in the beneficiary record is current. The case coordinator and/or designated Patient Service Representative will scan the Restraining Order immediately into the beneficiary's record.
- 3. The case coordinator will immediately notify the Quality Department at 415-QA@co.monterey.ca.us of this completed action.
- 4. Upon receipt of email from the case coordinator about the scanned Restraining Order, the Medical Records Technician (MRT) and/or QI Designee will complete the Verification of Receipt of Restraining Order form in Avatar. The MRT and/or QI Designee will mail a copy of the Verification of Receipt of Restraining Order form to the requesting party.
- 5. The Medical Records Technician and/or QI Designee will place an Alert in the beneficiary's chart. The specific alert verbiage shall say: "Warning: Restraining Order in Place. Information Sharing Restricted to Identified Person. See scanned document."
- 6. The Alert shall remain in the beneficiary's chart until MCBH is provided with proof that the Restraining Order with provision has been lifted and/or unless an end date has been identified on the received Restraining Order document.
