NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Supervisors of Monterey County will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, May 11, 2021, at 1:30 p.m. at the Monterey County Government Center, 168 W. Alisal Street, 1st Floor, Salinas, CA to close the 30-day public comment period prior to the Board of Supervisors considering adoption of the Monterey Urban County FY2021-22 Action Plan (AP) which identifies specific projects & programs that the Urban County intends to implement with CDBG funds.

The draft AP will be available for a 30-day Public Comment Period prior to the Public Hearing from April 10, 2021 to May 11, 2021. Public participation and/or written comments from any person, or their duly appointed representative, having an interest in the following Urban County jurisdictions are invited: the unincorporated areas of the County and the Cities of Del Rey Oaks, Gonzales, Greenfield, and Sand City collectively known as the "Urban County" for CDBG purposes.

The objectives and eligible CDBG Program activities to be considered in the adoption of the AP include: Public Services, Homeless Services, Affordable Housing, Public Facilities and Infrastructure projects/ programs, and Economic Development. For FY2021/22, the Urban County anticipates having approximately \$1,350,488 in CDBG funds available. The applications and projects recommended for funding are:
