Dear CAWD Board,

I have been a licensed Landscape Architect (Lic 1784) and a licensed Landscape Contractor (Lic, 276972) for approximately 50 years. Over the years I gained a vast wealth of experience. Over and over I have learned that simpler is better. Simpler is reliable and takes less maintenance. The new concept of adding 3 grinder / pumps is far more complicated and depends on uninterrupted electrical power, complex machinery, periodic and emergency maintenance, and a host of plumbing fittings, electrical wiring, electrical connections (a frequent weak point) and physical disruption for construction.

To my knowledge, the existing system has worked well for well for over 40 years. It makes no sense that a complex system be installed.
