## Topic

In alignment with California Advancing and Innovating Medi-Cal (CalAIM) payment reform billing and to continue making steps towards improved integration in the electronic health record with Specialty Mental Health Services (SMHS) and Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS), SUD Provider Agencies will transition from using the SUD Progress Note form to using the **Clinical Progress Note MC** (for OP/IOP/NTP LOCs).

## Procedure

1. **Effective for all dates of service starting 8/14/2023.**
2. SUD Progress Note will no longer be available after 8/25/2023.
3. DMC-ODS treatment providers for OP/IOP/NTP will begin using the Clinical Progress Note MC to document all individual services for beneficiaries in MyAvatar.
4. Start and End times will no longer be required.
5. All requirements for documentation standards and timeliness, as outlined in [MCBH QI Memo-CalAIM Implementation 002-Progress Notes](#), remains the same.
