**Narrative:** On September 21 at 4:50 pm an agricultural vehicle carrying strawberries overturned while attempting to avoid a head on collision. The vehicle went onto a hill adjacent to Crazy Horse Canyon Rd. in Salinas. The vehicle's fuel tank was cracked and released an estimated 5 gallons of diesel onto the road and dirt shoulder about 0.1 mile from Hidden Canyon Rd, and Crazy Horse Canyon Road. California Towing and California Highway Patrol noticed the fuel leak as the vehicle was being lifted. The leak was contained, and soil was scraped at the top surface of the shoulder. Additional clean up to be completed after 811 is contacted to ensure no utility lines are near the release.
