Narrative: On October 10th at 4:00 pm a notification was received of a fire on Hartnell Rd., in Salinas that involved a tractor losing hydraulic oil and diesel. The fire began around 1:00 pm, Monterey County Regional Fire Dept., arrived on scene, extinguished the flames and secured the scene. All Environmental Services representative Brandon Espinoza, set up the mitigation plan with Monterey County Environmental Health for a future date of 10/17/2023. It was estimated that a total of 40 gallons of hydraulic oil and less than 200 gallons of diesel were released into the soil.


