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**Narrative:** I received a call from Fire Comm about a restaurant fire at Chipotle Mexican Grill restaurant by Del Monte Center. I called Chief Grogan from Monterey Fire Department, he informed me that the fire started from one of their cooking equipment but the facility's fire suppression system did not activate. I made it on-site, talked to Gustavo Ramirez, facility's General Manager, was informed the fire was put out with their portable fire extinguisher, and their Ansul system did not deploy. The source of the fire was their gas powered rice cooker and no other food was affected. I confirmed the kitchen was already cleaned and sanitized. I issued a reopen order to the restaurant at 10:45 am.
