



Camping Rules & Regulations

Welcome to Camping at Laguna Seca Recreation Area and WeatherTech Raceway Laguna Seca!

We are excited that you will be camping with us and we want your experience here to be safe and fun for everyone. By reserving a space at our campgrounds, you and your fellow camper(s) agree to abide by all rules and regulations. Camping rules and regulations are subject to change without notice.

Event Camping Check-In Hours of Operation

Please check your camping ticket for details.

Check-In/Out

- Camping check-in location is at the bottom of A-Road off of HWY 68 (main entrance).
- All campers must present their ID/DL upon check-in.
- A camping ticket is required for check-in with proof of admission tickets for all campers 16 years of age or older.
- Confirmation letters or emails are not valid for check-in.
- You will be issued one (1) support vehicle tag (Camping Parking Pass) upon arrival along with camping band(s) for each camper, children 15 and under excluded.
- Camping bands to be worn at all times and is required for exiting and re-entering the park throughout your stay.
- Check out will be no later than 12 p.m. on Monday for all Premier, Reserved, and General RV sites for Trans Am SpeefFest, Motul Course de Monterey Powered by Hyundai N, Ferrari Challenge North America, Firestone Grand Prix of Monterey, and Monterey Pre-Reunion & Corkscrew Hillclimb. Check out for Rolex Monterey Motorsports Reunion will be on by 12 p.m. on Sunday for all Premier, Reserved, and General RV sites.

Camper Cancellation Policy

Laguna Seca Recreation Area / WeatherTech Raceway Laguna Seca does not issue refunds or exchanges. All sales are final.

Basic Campsite Rules

 Each campsite must have one camper who is at least 18 years old (no unattended children or youth permitted).

- Each campsite is allowed up to 6 adults, with the exception of General Tent and General RV Camping, not including children ages 15 and under.
- Please stay within your designated campsite space; do not encroach on your neighbor.
- Each campsite is allowed one (1) vehicle + one (1) tent, or one (1) RV + one (1) vehicle. A vehicle pass for one (1) extra vehicle is available for Premier and Reserved Camping sites. The extra vehicle pass cannot be purchased for General Camping.
- Each vehicle in the campground areas must display a Camping Parking Pass that is issued upon check-in for your specific site and will need to be visible for security purposes.
- All vehicles not permitted for a designated campsite will be charged and towed at the owner's expense.

Camp Fires

- No open (on the ground) fires and no smudge spots.
- Fires are permitted in enclosed containers, such as charcoal grills, and in any fire rings or grills located at the campsite. Grand Prix "A", Chaparral "B", and Can-Am Circle "C" Campgrounds have provided fire rings.
- Firewood bundles are available for purchase at \$15 per bundle at the entry station.

Campsite Parking

- Vehicles must be parked appropriately; do not block traffic or fire lanes.
- Please make sure the Camping Parking Pass is clearly visible at all times and stays within the vehicle.
- If you have a support vehicle with a Class A, B, or C or trailer then hang your Camping Pass on the support vehicle and if you do not, then hang the Camping Pass on the RV.
- Visitors attending the event are allowed in your campsite, however their vehicles are not.

Campsite Security

- Laguna Seca Recreation Area is not responsible for any lost or stolen items from your campsite, vehicle or trailer, including Camping Parking Passes.
- Keep your vehicle locked at all times. Personal property should not be left unattended.
- Security hours are 5 p.m. to 3 a.m. nightly. Please report suspicious activity by calling Security at 831-578-3379.

Pets

- Pets are allowed, but not recommended.
- Pets are only allowed in campsites and in the campground area. A maximum of two (2) pets allowed.
- Pets are not allowed in any other areas of the venue including all racing and event areas.
- Pets may not be left unattended or left outside a vehicle or tent.
- Each pet must be on a 6' leash at all times.

- Please pick up after your pet and dispose of waste properly.
- Proof of vaccinations is required.

Quiet Hours

Quiet hours are to be observed from 10:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m. Please abide by the Quiet Hours and respect your fellow neighbors. Quiet hours restrict loud talking, parties, generators, music, and barking dogs.

Water

Water at Laguna Seca Recreation Area is non-potable. Please do not drink or cook with the water. We recommend you bring your own bottled water or filtration system.

Dumping Gray Water

Dumping gray water onto the ground is prohibited. There is a complimentary, self-serve, central disposal station located at the top of A-Road, however, dump station hours are only open after 7 p.m. once the event has concluded. Please plan accordingly.
