

Narrative: Our office received OES Spill Report 24-1003 and I was asked to contact the California Highway Patrol Monterey Office by Randy McMurray, Supervisor for Hazardous Materials Management Services (HMMS). I then spoke with CHP Officer Mallory who confirmed the report details and requested HMMS response to the scene for site observation & cleanup oversight. I responded, checked-in with Officer Mallory, who showed me the spill area which included private property (762 Hall Rd). We spoke with the property owner (Esperanza Ramirez) and son (David Ramirez) who allowed us to observe the impact extent on their property so that it could be mitigated as well. A cleanup contractor (Clean Harbors Environmental) was reached by the responsible party and cleanup of the affected shoulder, and front driveway area of 762 Hall Rd was completed on Saturday, February 17, from 7 am to 4 pm. Approximately 18 55-gallons drums were filled with soil and removed Monday, February 19th per Clean Harbors Staff. Shawn Atkins, Maintenance Manager for Monterey County Public Work, Facilities, and Parks was contacted on 02/17/2024 at ~9:30 am with a status update, and he indicated that his office would backfill the area with clean soil on Tuesday, February 20, 2024. A copy of the signed-Treatment Storage Disposal Facility (TSDF) manifest(s) will be provided to HMMS within ~45 days by Clean Harbors Environmental. Monterey County HMMS Staff Oscar Piaquinto-Morales and Amr Hassanein also responded to the scene.
