

Narrative: Randy McMurray, Supervisor, Hazardous Materials Management Services forwarded OES Spill report 24-0757 and requested an update. I contacted Caren Wilhoit, PG&E Environmental Officer, who confirmed the report details, that the oil was contained in a ditch, and that she was working to have the area excavated once it is checked for underground utilities via an 811 request as well as ensuring all power line safety concerns are eliminated before excavation / containerizing of the oil / soil mixture; she indicated Thursday, 02/08/2024 is the likely day that cleanup will occur and that she would contact me to confirm. The cause of the spill was the high wind due to the storm event.
