Narrative:

As the on-call personnel, I took over the incident response after 5PM relieving Amr Hassanein. Clean Harbors was onsite at approximately 4:30 PM and was preparing to fill their wash down tank with water from a tap from the Grill restaurant. Rudy Ramos, Field Service Supervisor, 669-236-0687, was onsite with two staff; two additional personnel joined the team around 8PM.

There were three spill areas in the parking lot including the location where the tanker caught fire. The storm drain was blocked off from further runoff. Cleaning began around 7:30PM and lasted until around 11PM leaving a smaller section left to complete. Rain began to fall around 9PM and was intermittent with occasional heavy downpour. All equipment was secured onsite within the affected area which was sectioned off from the public.

Clean-up resumed the following day around 8AM. Clean Harbors, cleaned the last section then used absorbent to remove surface oil from rainwater pooled around the storm drain. The remaining water was then released. Clean-up was completed at 1:00 PM. The truck with the waste barrels was left onsite for pick-up on Monday. Follow-up is required for copies of the manifest.


