#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

It is recommended that the Fish and Game Advisory Commission receive Public Works, Facilities, & Parks (PWFP) Fish and Game Propagation Fund Fiscal Year 2023-24 Financial Summary Report through April 30, 2024.

#### **SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:**

PWFP Fish and Game Propagation Fund Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-24 financial update through April 30, 2024, reflects actual revenue from Other Court Fines of \$20,505, Settlements of \$13,000 and Interest of \$1,245. The expenditures in this period are \$9,534 Cost Plan charges and \$575 for Advertising for the FY24 Propagation Grants.

#### **OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:**

None.

#### **FINANCING**:

The beginning fund balance for FY 2023-24 is \$76,717. Revenues budgeted in FY 2023-24 are \$45,029 and budgeted expenditures are \$51,636. The estimated FY 2023-24 ending fund balance is \$70,110.
