REPORT OF THE MANUAL TALLY

HARTNELL COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT, TRUSTEE AREA 6, SPECIAL VACANCY ELECTION
JUNE 4, 2024

1% Manual Tally of Paper Ballots: The 1% manual tally is defined by Election Codes §336.5 as the public process of manually tallying votes in one percent of the vote by mail batches and polling place voting precincts selected at random by the election official and one batch and precinct for each race not included in the random selections. This procedure is conducted during the official canvass to verify the accuracy of the automated count. This tally includes paper ballots cast at the polling place and by mail.

On Wednesday, April 3, 2024, Monterey County Elections emailed to interested parties and published the Public Observation Calendar informing the public of when and where the 1% manual tally was to take place. Additionally, a press release was also published on Thursday, May 30, 2024. Both the Observation Calendar and the press release were available on the Monterey County Elections website. Finally, a notice was placed on the Department's public bulletin board informing observers of the 1% manual tally activities and location.

On Thursday, June 6, 2024, at 9:00 a.m., the Elections Department publicly randomly selected the following for the 1% manual tally per Elections Code §15360(2):

- 1% vote by mail batches.
- 1% of early voting batches.
- 1% of polling place voting precincts.

Vote by mail batches were selected using 3 10-sided dice 3-digits batch sequence number.

Polling place voting precincts were selected using 3 10-sided dice to select 3-digit batch sequence number where each batch consisted of an entire polling place.

The following batches were selected to achieve 1% of vote my mail batches and covering all contests:

- Tabulator 6, Batch 004
- Tabulator 6, Batch 020
- Tabulator 6, Batch 010

Batch 308-003 was randomly selected to achieve 1% of all polling place voting precincts covering all contests. This batch covered all votes at the following polling place:

Soledad Community Center
560 Walker Dr Soledad, CA 93960

In addition, batch 207-001 was randomly selected to achieve 1% of early voting batches.

Results of the 1% Manual Tally of paper ballots: During the 1% manual tally, the Elections Department did not encounter any variances; confirming the accuracy of the results from the ImageCast™ Central (ICC) paper ballot tabulating machines and adjudication machines. The 1% Manual Tally was completed at 9:00 a.m. on Friday, June 7, 2024.
