MHRS/SWIII staff may contribute to the assessment consistent with their scope of practice and under the direction of the LPHA (licensed/licensed eligible). MHRS/SWIII may bill 331CA (extended service not required) when gathering assessment information

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES-QI MEMO

Monterey County Behavioral Health Quality Improvement department has developed the **FSP Eligibility Screening Tool** to establish and verify eligibility criteria for Full Service Partnership (FSP) programs. The FSP Eligibility Screening Tool identifies qualifying criteria that justify placement in an FSP level of care for children/youth (0-15), transition age youth (16-25), adults (26-59), and older adults (60+).

- Effective: 07/01/2024.
- FSP Eligibility Screening Tool will be required to confirm eligibility criteria are met for beneficiaries receiving FSP (Full Service Partnership) level of care.
- Required for all beneficiaries, of any age, who are currently enrolled in or entering an FSP.
- Required for both Monterey County Behavioral Health and contracted provider programs.
- Must be completed prior to opening the beneficiary to any FSP episode, annually thereafter to reestablish eligibility, and/or to transition the beneficiary out of the FSP episode.
 - o To note, if a beneficiary is transferred to a non-FSP episode, but subsequently requires FSP level of care at a later time, a new FSP Eligibility Screening Tool shall be completed
 - o For beneficiaries aging out of one FSP age grouping (for example, a beneficiary turning 26 and moving from the TAY to the Adult age category), the indicated age grouping will be required during the annual update and this feature is automated in the form in AVATAR.
- For beneficiaries who are already enrolled in an FSP program, the FSP Eligibility Screening Tool must be completed within 30 days, by 8/1/2024.

Effective **7/1/2024** the Reaching Recovery Level of care tools will no longer be required and will be removed from Avatar. This change is part of the ongoing quality improvement efforts to reduce documentation and bring our Behavioral health Organization into alignment with CalAIM. POLICIES AND PROCEDURES-QI MEMO

PAYMENT REFORM BILLING CHANGES *PLEASE READ - IMPORTANT INFORMATION*

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) has communicated additional changes related to payment reform related to the extended service add-on. Although these changes are to take effect 7/1/2024, the impact to provider staff is limited, in fact, it should simplify data entry into Avatar. Please review the changes below:

- Effective 7/1/2024
- Changes below apply to "Extended Service Add-ons" only other add-ons remain unchanged
- For services starting 7/1/2024, the "Extended Service Add-on" for Assessment, Therapy, and Medication Support service codes will no longer be required
 - o Provider staff will enter the entire service in the duration field
 - o Provider staff no longer need to memorize or refer to the extended service add-on rules
- For services prior to 7/1/2024, provider staff will continue to use current rules related to extended service add-on (see Documentation Guide, Add-on Matrix)
 - Provider staff will enter the extended service add-on maximum duration in the service duration field and then will add the extended service add-on via the add-on section
- All other add-on rules still apply including interactive complexity, interpretation, collateral, psychotherapy for medication support, and case management for medication support

In collaboration with MCBH services managers and staff, QI has created new AVATAR bundles in order to support staff with ensuring the required forms are completed when necessary. The bundles are available now and can be used by typing the name in the search box in AVATAR (see bolded name below).
