SAFE STORAGE & DISPOSAL



DO NOT throw sharps in the garbage!

Store and dispose of household sharps following these recommendations:

1. Obtain a sharps container from your local pharmacy or household hazardous waste (HHW) location.
2. Discard all used or exposed needles, syringes, and lancets in the sharps container.
3. When the sharps container is 2/3 full, dispose the container at an approved drop-off location.

Prevent accidental needle sticks and exposure to bloodborne pathogens in your home and in your community. Properly contain and dispose sharps.

NEVER place exposed or used sharps in the garbage can or recycle bin.
