4. BUDGET WORKSHOP FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016-2017

A. Monterey Regional Water Pollution Control Agency (MRWPCA) CSIP/SRDF/SVRP Proposed FY 2016-2017 Budget

MRWPCA Staff reviewed their budget via PowerPoint presentation. Presenters included Tori Hannah, Chief Financial Officer; Mark Malanka, Maintenance Manager; James Dix, Operations Manager; and, Steve Hogg, Deputy General Manager.

B. Monterey County Water Resources Agency Proposed FY 2016-2017 Budget

Cathy Paladini, Finance Manager, reviewed the Agency's specific budget areas, with considerable time devoted to discussion of reserves.

The Finance Manager submitted the following recommendations for consideration by the Board of Directors:

- 1. Direct Agency Staff to find a revenue stream for Agency regulatory requirements;
 - Fish monitoring and SRM Lagoon, if no revenue is found, Staff will need to determine the risk of not performing these activities
- 2. In the event further cutbacks are required, request Agency Staff to prioritize projects in Fund 116;
 - Determine if the proposed fund labor allocation meets Agency priorities
 - Determine if a cloud seeding program should be pursued in light of existing money for SRSMP and Lagoon permits
 - Determine if consultant costs meet Agency priorities
- 3. Approve annual COLA increase on Flood Zone Assessments; and, direct Agency Staff to complete an updated water service/delivery fee policy by 6/30/17 (Directors -
 - Approve COLA increases on flood assessments (excludes water delivery/service fees and Debt Service Fund 133)
 - Establish a minimum fee that addresses the interrelated shared O&M costs between CSIP, SVRP and SRDF; and,
- 4. Direct Agency Staff to obtain a source of revenue before working on unfunded projects
 - Lagoon permitting
 - 11043
 - GSA

Director Comments: Requested a sub-committee be formed to address policy change related to WRA BOS Resolution 00-172 and that it be presented at the next WRA BOD meeting.
