- The Board of Directors approved four contract amendments through fiscal year 2014-2015.



Financial Impact

- Total Cost: \$49,450.
- Payable from: Fiscal Year 2015-16, Fund 116, Dam Operations and Maintenance.



- The Agency sent out a Request for Proposals to 20 qualified consulting engineering firms for dam safety surveillance and performance evaluation services. Two firms submitted proposals, AECOM and TERRA Engineers, Inc.
- The cost estimate to complete Tasks 1-6 (required by the California Department of Water Resources Division of Safety of Dams) is the following:

AECOM - \$39,940 Terra Engineers, Inc. - \$27,592

 AECOM is recommended for their experience with San Antonio Dam, reporting requirements, and quality of deliverables.

Scope of Work needed to satisfy dam performance evaluation needs and DSOD requirements are Tasks 1-6:

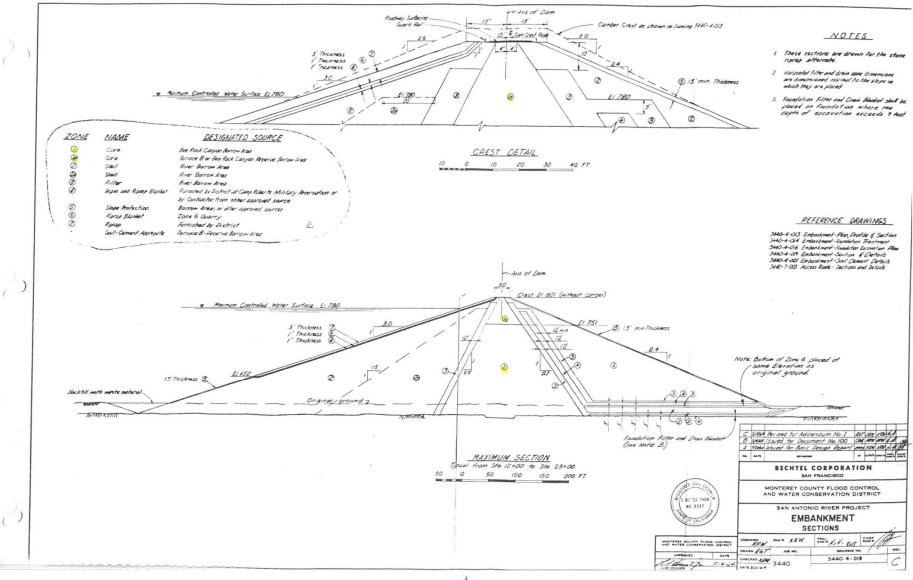

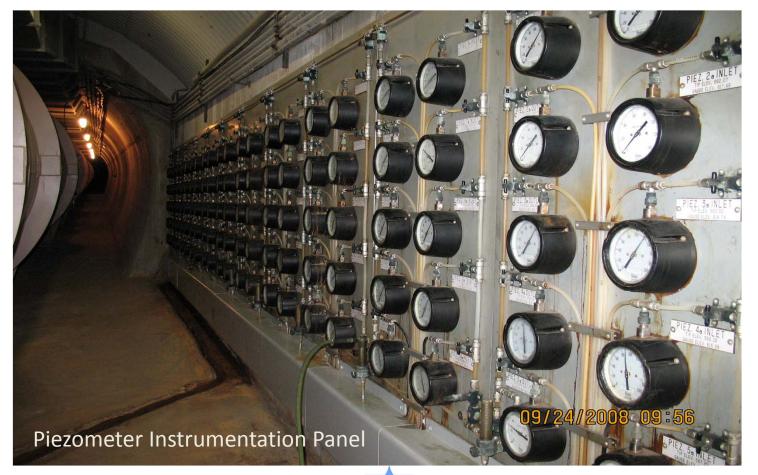


Measuring seepage flow from a Left Abutment horizontal drain.

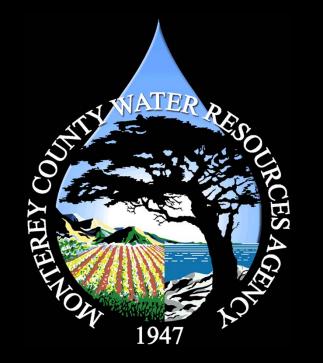
Summary

- This Agreement is for a five-year term commencing on July 1, 2015, and is renewable on annual basis depending on the satisfactory completion of the contract requirements.

Financial Impact

- This budget amendment re-allocates reimbursed revenue of \$600,000 in Fund 116 from the County of Monterey that was used to finance the Inter-lake Tunnel Project
 - Enables the Agency to pay for this project and other budgeted Dam Program Projects



- The FY 2014-15 appropriated budgeted funds in 116 Dam Operations was leveraged to pay EPC invoices for the Inter-lake Tunnel Project.
- The County reimbursement agreement allows for these invoices to be reimbursed upon approval from the CAO within 30 days.
- The County is over 90 days late in approving and reimbursing the Agency for EPC invoices and this delay is impeding the Agency from working on Dam Projects required by DSOD.
- The Agency will be working with the County to address this issue with the third reimbursement agreement.

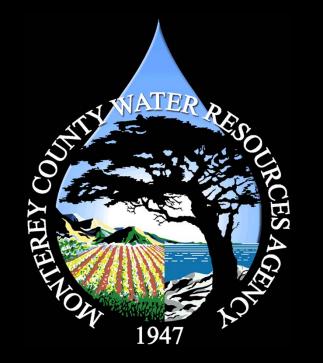

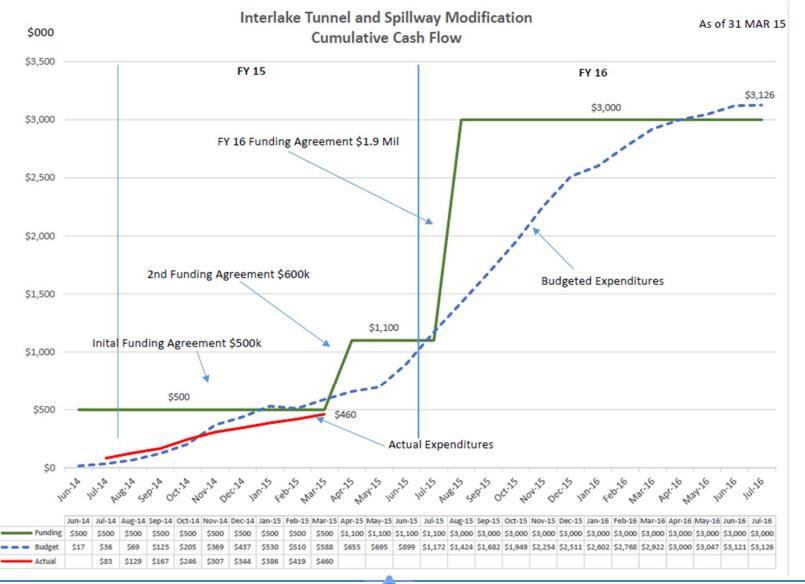
This Third Reimbursement and Funding Agreement will cause the County to reimburse to the Agency up to the sum of \$2,026,000 for the purpose of funding to perform an updated scope of work, that would include the Spillway Modification at San Antonio, and to perform geotechnical and final design engineering; permitting and environmental approval; financing plan preparation and implementation; technical support to the agency, and implementation and program management services.



- This sum is in addition to the sum of \$500,000 that was to be reimbursed under the First Reimbursement Agreement, and \$600,000 to be reimbursed under the Second Reimbursement Agreement.
- Funding for services in Fiscal Year 2017 will be subject to a negotiated Fourth Reimbursement and Funding Agreement, and subject to available appropriations during the Fiscal Year 2017 budget process.
