### **MINUTES**

### 1. ROLL CALL

Chair Richard Ortiz called the meeting to order at 2:20 PM and a quorum was established.

#### 2. SCHEDULED MATTERS

#### A. Consider:

- i) Authorizing the Monterey County Water Resources Agency to proceed with the Interlake Tunnel Project, including spillway modifications as a key component of the Interlake Tunnel Project;
- ii) Authorizing the General Manager of the Monterey County Water Resources Agency to prepare and issue Requests for Proposal for geotechnical and final design engineering; permitting and environmental approval; and, financing plan preparation and implementation;
- Requesting the Monterey County Board of Supervisors to authorize proceeding with negotiation of a funding agreement between Monterey County and the Monterey County Water Resources Agency for an amount not to exceed \$2.5 million to perform geotechnical and final design engineering; permitting and environmental approval; financing plan preparation and implementation; and, program management services, all

- for the Interlake Tunnel Project, said funds to be reimbursed to Monterey County if the Project is financed; and,
- iv) Authorizing the Monterey County Water Resources Agency to negotiate a Project Labor Agreement to be utilized by the contractors selected to construct the Interlake Tunnel Project.

David Chardavoyne, Water Resources Agency General Manager, presented these items for consideration. (Included Slides and PowerPoint presentation)

- a. Authorized the Monterey County Water Resources Agency to proceed with the Interlake Tunnel Project, including spillway modifications as a key component of the Interlake Tunnel Project;
- b. Authorized the General Manager of the Monterey County Water Resources Agency to prepare and issue Requests for Proposal for geotechnical and final design engineering; permitting and environmental approval; and, financing plan preparation and implementation;
- c. The Monterey County Board of Supervisors authorized proceeding with negotiation of a funding agreement between Monterey County and the Monterey County Water Resources Agency for an amount not to exceed \$2.5 million to perform geotechnical and final design engineering; permitting and environmental approval; financing plan preparation and implementation; and, program management services, all for the Interlake Tunnel Project, said funds to be reimbursed to Monterey County if the Project is financed; and,
- d. Authorized the Monterey County Water Resources Agency to negotiate a Project Labor Agreement to be utilized by the contractors selected to construct the Interlake Tunnel Project.
- e. Directed staff to return in January 2015 with a report regarding the timeline and costs in terms of the design/build process and where the Project Labor Agreement fits in;
- f. Directed that the design build process, as set out in the recent amendments to the Water Resources Agency Act AB155-the Alejo Bill, shall be followed to award contracts for the final design and construction of the Interlake Tunnel Project and ancillary facilities;
- g. The Board of Supervisors of the Monterey County Water Resources Agency shall approve all project documents required by AB155 prior to issuance of request for proposals or qualifications to design build entities for final design and construction of the Interlake Tunnel Project and agency staff shall actively pursue legislation and grants to fund design construction of the project; and staff shall provide a report to the Board of Supervisors of the Monterey County Water Resources Agency no later than February 2015 on grant opportunities and on funding activities undertaken by the agency.
