Hi Martha,

I received your request this morning to send you an email with more detailed information about our request.

We are working with the Monterey County Planning Department in preparing an Environmental Impact Report for the Paraiso Springs Resort project outside of Soledad. The project proposes to redevelop the Paraiso Springs site to include 103 hotel units and 77 time share units, restaurants, and conference rooms.

To our knowledge, the project site is located in Beat #10 of the County Sheriff's patrol, which covers a large area of the Central Salinas Valley. This patrol has a relatively long response times (e.g. greater than 10 minutes). The proposed project would have on-site security, with the

Sheriff's department acting as a second responder. In addition, all visitors would pass through a security gate at the main entrance, which would significantly reduce crime within the project site.

Our questions: does the Sheriff's department foresee having to construct new, or expand existing facilities in order to maintain service response times to serve the proposed project?

Please let me know if you need any more information. Please see if you can have a response this week or early next week, as this is a time sensitive project.
