#### What are the Questions?

Do I need to file a FLAN for a Permit Extension?

#### **Short Answer:**

Yes, if the original project approval was appealable to the California Coastal Commission, a FLAN for the extension must be filed.

#### Discussion:

Section 30603 (d) of the Coastal Act states that when a local government takes an action on a coastal development permit, the local government shall send notification of its final action to the commission by certified mail within seven <u>calendar</u> days from the date of taking the action. Subsection (c) of the same section states that the decision shall become final at the close of business on the 10th <u>working</u> day from the date of receipt by the commission of the notice of the local government's final action, unless an appeal is submitted within that time. This language has been broadly interpreted by California Coastal Commission (CCC) staff to extend to amendments and extensions of permits as well.

#### Facts of the situation:

Amendments and extensions of Coastal Administrative Permits and Coastal Development Permits follow the same protocol. Once an amendment is prepared, a notice to approve the amendment is mailed and posted. The public is given 10 working days to object to the amendment. If no written objections are received within the 10 working days, the amendment approval shall become final and shall be signed by the Director of Planning.

Extensions of Variances, Emergency Permits, and Combined Development Permits follow a protocol similar to the amendment/extension protocol noted above. Pursuant to the public noticing requirements under Monterey County Code Section 20.84.040.A, once an extension is prepared, a notice to approve the extension is mailed and posted at least 10 days prior to the date the extension is intended to be approved. The public is given 10 <u>calendar</u> days to object to the extension. If no written objections are received within the 10 <u>calendar</u> days, the extension approval shall become final and shall be signed by the Director of Planning.

Once the permit amendment or extension is signed by the Director of Planning, a FLAN shall be prepared and sent to the CCC within seven <u>calendar</u> days of the date the amendment or extension is approved by the Director of Planning.

Upon receipt of the FLAN, the CCC has 10 working days to appeal the amendment or extension. This requirement adds a minimum 21 additional calendar days to the time when the amendment or extension will receive final approval.
