


What is a pesticide?

- Substances designed to be harmful to a target
- Purposely introduced into the environment to control pests such as insects, bacteria, weeds, or rodents
- California includes adjuvants and plant growth regulators in the definition












Pesticide Types





Agricultural Use

Food and Agricultural Code (FAC) 11408 definition

"Agricultural use" means the use of any

 pesticide/method/device used to control plant or animal pests or other pests









Agricultural Use

Agricultural use does not include pesticides meant for:

- (a) Home use.
- **(b)** Use in structural pest control.
- (c) Industrial or institutional use.
- (d) The control of an animal pest under the written prescription of a veterinarian.





What is an Agricultural Commodity?

Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) definition:

An unprocessed product of farms, ranges, nurseries and forests (except livestock, poultry and fish) including:

- Fruits & Vegetables
- Grains & Legumes
- Rangeland and pasture
- Seed crops
- Fiber crops
- Oil crops
- Nursery stock
- Christmas trees
- Ornamental and cut flowers
- Turf grown for Sod





Cannabis defined as an agricultural commodity

January 2017 - DPR reevaluated Pr

Department of Pesticide Regulation



- Cannabis now meets the definition of agricultural commodity
 - Cannabis is now subject to production agriculture regulations
 - Subject to use reporting under 3 CCR 6626

SUBJECT: PRELIMINARY GUIDANCE ON COUNTY PESTICIDE ENFORCEMENT

RELATED TO COMMERCIAL CANNABIS CULTIVATION AND CANNABIS DEFINED AS AN AGRICULTURAL COMMODITY

Lastly, DPR has determined that cannabis meets the definition of an "agricultural commodity" in 3 CCR § 6000, and therefore, any requirement placed on pesticide use on for the production of an agricultural commodity in Divisions 6 and 7 of the Food and Agricultural Code and its implementing regulations, applies to cannabis. One significant impact of this determination is that cannabis growers will be subject to pesticide use reporting requirements under 3 CCR § 6626—as opposed to 3 CCR § 6627. An updated handout to reflect this requirement is attached.



State regulation requires that:

Any property operator using a pesticide for agricultural use must maintain records of pesticide use (Pesticide Use Records 3 CCR 6624)

Any property operator producing an agricultural commodity shall report the use of registered pesticides applied to the crop, commodity or site to the commissioner of the county in which the pest control was performed (Production Pesticide Use Reports 3 CCR 6626)

What do I need to submit report?

The first step to being able to submit a pesticide use report

 Obtain an operator identification number (OIN) or Op-ID) from the county agricultural commissioner (CAC)

Purpose of the OIN/Op-ID

The main purpose:

Track pesticide use

- By operation
- commodity









You need an OIN for:

USE

OIN is needed:

- If you plan to do any pesticide work
- If you plan to purchase any agricultural or Federal Restricted-Use rodenticides

RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE

Due to Hazard to Nontarget Organisms For retail sale to and use only by Certified Applicators or persons under their direct supervision and only for those uses covered by the Certified Applicator's certification.

How do I obtain an OIN?

To apply for an OIN, you must present to the CAC:

- Business or Firm name
- Name of the authorized representative
- Contact info:
 - mailing & physical address
 - phone numbers
- Ranch name, size, location, maps
- Commodity list

How do I obtain an OIN?

Your application will be assigned to a biologist to create the OIN paperwork.

Once complete, the biologist will make an appointment with you to issue the OIN.

Once issued, you are ready to submit pesticide use reports (PURs)



Pesticides Use Reports (PURs)

Three different types of reports

1. Production Agricultural

Use of pesticides for the production of an agricultural commodity

2. Non-Production Agriculture

 Use of pesticides to control pests on agricultur land or areas that are not being used to produagricultural commodity.

3. Non-Ag.

Use of pesticide in areas that are not production non-production agriculture





Production PURs

When is this reported required?

Use of any pesticide when applied with the purpose of producing an agricultural commodity

Examples

- Application to flowers, foliage
- Pre-plant applications



Non-production/non-ag use report

When is this reported required?

 When a pesticide is applied to areas/locations not involved with the production of an agricultural commodity

Examples

- Weed control on roadways
- Water disinfections
- Rodenticides for squirrels, mice, gophers, etc.




Then click on the link at the bottom





Enter treated area and units






Enter the product used. (By name or registration number)

The save buttons

- Save Line New Product
 - Copies the date and location, you enter new pesticides
- Save Line New Date
 - Copies only the location, you enter new date and pesticides
- Save Line New Site/Date
 - Copies just the permit name, you enter new date, location and pesticides





The save buttons


- Save Line Done
 - Saves the current pesticide data line and closes the PUR for saving to Draft or to Submit to County
- Clear Line
 - Erase the current pesticide data being entered





Finalizing the report

Report prepared by, and date are optional You can then save the PUR in draft or submit it






Validation Error

- Respiratory protection program records
- Inspection of the pesticide storage
