**Subject:** Re: Carmel Valley Emergency Response Plan

Kathleen, Many thanks for the 118 pages. Having scanned them here are a few comments. (1) Page 47 George Whisler is listed as the emergency contact for Arroyo Carmel. George is no longer able to coordinate to coordinate the emergency response at Arroyo. Please list me as the emergency contact until I find someone else.. I wonder how many other association contact people have changed, moved, et.

(2) Page 82. Arroyo's population is no longer well versed in emergency preparedness. I have given Paul Ireland's COPE plan to the Board here but do not expect an immediate response or action. I would estimate that at least half the population of Arroyo is new since the floods of '95 and the flood of '98.

(3) Page 58. The Carmel Middle School gym is the gathering place for those of us at the mouth of the Valley. What is the maximum occupancy? Not only do we have the big hotel just east of Highway One with tourists who may have to be evacuated but also 87 units at Riverwood, and 92 units at Arroyo. Add another potential 1,000 people from the proposed Rancho Canada Village and I see standing room only.

(4). I see the word challenging used so many times regarding evacuation in Carmel Valley that it frightens me. I also was surprised at the number of roads in the Valley that are affected by flooding.

(5) The plan, in my opinion, is for coordinating the various first responders. I did not learn anything to help me aid with the evacuation of Arroyo.

I think it high time to stop approving large subdivisions in Carmel Valley until the reverse 911 plan is in effect. And I will insist that buyers of Rancho Canada Village homes be forewarned about the emergency evacuation mess at the mouth of the Valley via a strong condition insisting upon same.
