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An ambulance should be used appropriately. Documentation is necessary to ensure the ambulance companies are accurately reimbursed.

Procedure

- 1. An ambulance may be used for:
 - A. Persons being transferred from the crisis unit of Natividad Medical Center on a W & IC 5150 evaluation and treatment when the application indicates behavior that is a risk, gravely disabled, or dangerous to self and others.
 - B. Consumers being transferred from a 24-hour acute psychiatric inpatient unit to another, on a 72-hour evaluation and treatment, or 14-day certification, or conservator ship legal status who has exhibited AWOL (exiting the hospital setting without permission while on a therapeutic hold) behaviors, dangerous behaviors to self and/or others, and may require restraints.
 - C. Consumers in a locked facility requiring transfer to a 24-hour acute Psychiatric inpatient facility whose behaviors indicated an AWOL risk or dangerous to self or others.

D. Consumers in an acute residential facility, (i.e., crisis group home), outpatient clinic, necessitating transfer to a 24-hour acute psychiatric inpatient facility for evaluation and treatment for reason of dangerous behaviors to self and/or others.
