2 Policy

The Behavioral Health committee and staff meetings are conducted for a specific purpose, and the punctual attendance of assigned committee and staff members at called or regularly scheduled meetings is considered to be part of their official duties. Attendance is therefore mandatory unless specifically excused.

This policy applies to regular unit and divisional staff meetings, Quality Management Utilization Review and Quality Improvement Committee meetings, staff case conferences, task force and training committees and any special meetings called by supervisory or management personnel.
