Narrative:

On January 2, 2020 at 10:15 p.m., County Communications Dispatch Center contacted the Environmental Health Bureau regarding a sewage spill that had occurred at the Vist Point Apartments located at 650 Jewel Ave. in Pacific Grove. I arrived on scene at 10:50 pm and met with Monterey Fire Captain Brian Holm who showed me the cleanout where a Roto Rooter technician had removed the blockage as well as the hallway of affected apartments 103, 104 105, 106, 108 and 109. Relatively small amounts of sewage (less than one gallon) had spilled into each bathroom. Crews from Roto Rooter had already vacuumed up all surface moisture. Crews from El Dorado Cleaning then applied a sanitizing agent called P-Lime-Zyme to the affected areas and vacuumed that up. Several residence complained that these spills were a reoccurring problem and that this was the fifth time in a year that a blockage resulting in a spill had occurred.

I cleared the scene at 11:45 p.m..


