RP advised that there is a sludge substance that smells like sewage or brine and had a sheen or shine to it. It appears that about 20 gallons were on the street and the additional 100 gallons were on or near the beach. Daleo Construction was on site, seeming to be the head of a drilling project nearby, possibly causing the release. The RP approached the workers, asking to speak with the supervisor to get clarification on the release. RP was met with negativity, not able to gain any further information. The sludge that is on the beach appeared to be pushed around by a truck, toward local businesses. There was an orange fence that was put up to separate the sludge from the ocean however, it appeared to be failing and sludge soaked sand was seeping into the ocean as the tide was rising.
