**Narrative:**

On January 27, 2020 at 5:45 p.m., County Communications Dispatch Center contacted the Environmental Health Bureau regarding a sewer spill that had occurred at 158 Okinawa Rd in Seaside. I contacted Marina Coast Water District Supervisor Corey Luongo who was on scene. He described the main line blockage that had caused the release of 125 gallons of sewage onto the street and into a storm drain catch basin. The Sewage did not exit the catch basin. Mr. Luongo's crews cleared the blockage restoring normal flow and vacuumed out the catch basin. They also washed down the surface contamination and vacuumed up the rinsate. Finally, they applied a 10% bleach solution to the affected areas. I arrived on scene at 6:25 pm and verified cleanup. There were no solids or standing puddles and I could smell bleach.

I cleared the scene at 6:40 p.m..


