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Narrative:

At 11:34 AM I was notified by Dispatched to call Captain Justin Cooper, Monterey City Fire. Captain Fontaine was on-scene at a restaurant fire located at the Carmel Coffee House and Roasting Company on Ocean Ave, cross street Dolores. Captain Cooper reported that the roaster caught fire causing the coffee shop to fill with smoke. Evacuation was necessary. The fire was put out with no damage to the building structure (walls or floor).


I was onsite at 11:55 AM and met with Captain Cooper briefly and spoke with the manager of the facility, Linda Perry. I saw no evidence of fire to the structure. The fire was contained within the coffee roaster. I issued an inspection report to Ms. Perry directing her to either repair or replace the roaster before use and the Consumer Protection would follow-up the following week.

Monterey Fire okayed the building to be occupied and I concurred. I left the scene approximately 12:30 PM.
