

## **SALINAS RIVER CHANNEL STREAM MAINTENANCE PROGRAM PARTICIPATION CHECKLIST**

### **INITIAL PROJECT ASSESSMENT**

- 1. Contact RMU Executive Director to express interest**
- 2. Determine if you have channels on your property**
  - a. Access webpage to look up channels by APN*
- 3. Meet with RCD and RMU to review Stream Maintenance Program Requirements**
  - a. Discuss program structure and requirements*
    - i. Three permits:
      1. Army Corps (404) – MCWRA permit holder
      2. Regional Water Quality Control Board (401) – MCWRA permit holder
      3. CA Fish & Wildlife (1600) – RCD Permit holder
  - b. Mitigation requirement maintenance*
    - i. Different requirements for the different permits

### **RIVER MANAGEMENT UNIT MEMBERSHIP/SIGN PERMIT AGREEMENTS**

- 4. Enroll property in River Management Unit Association and sign permit agreements**
  - a. River Management Unit (RMU) Membership – processed by RMU ED*
    - i. Membership Form
    - ii. Fee Schedule
  - b. Permit paperwork – processed by MCWRA and RCD directly*
    - i. MCRWA Agreement – for 404 and 401 permits
    - ii. RCD agreement – for 1600 permit

### **DEVELOP ANNUAL WORKPLAN**

- 5. Develop workplan to obtain approvals for work**
  - a. Determine which channels and what type of work desired for each channel*
  - b. Develop 3 different workplans – agency develops with direction from landowner*
    - i. 1600 workplan requires Verification Request Form
      1. Fees due based on the type of work requested
    - ii. 404 workplan
    - iii. 401 workplan
  - c. Obtain approvals from each permitting agency*
- 6. Pre-work requirements**
  - a. Boundaries flagged and pre-maintenance surveys*
  - b. Vegetation Mapping for new channels (one-time only)*
  - c. Habitat assessments*

*d. Training for responsible party and landowner (form signed)*

**7. WORK**

*a. RCD informs landowner clear to work*

*b. RCD and responsible party determine work/contact structure*

*c. RCD helps coordinate work days*

**8. POST-WORK**

*a. RCD invoices RMU Association*

*b. RMU Association invoices each landowner/operator directly*

*c. Identify plan for next year*

*d. RCD compiles reports (one for each agency) after each fall season and submits*
