### APPROXIMATE SIZE

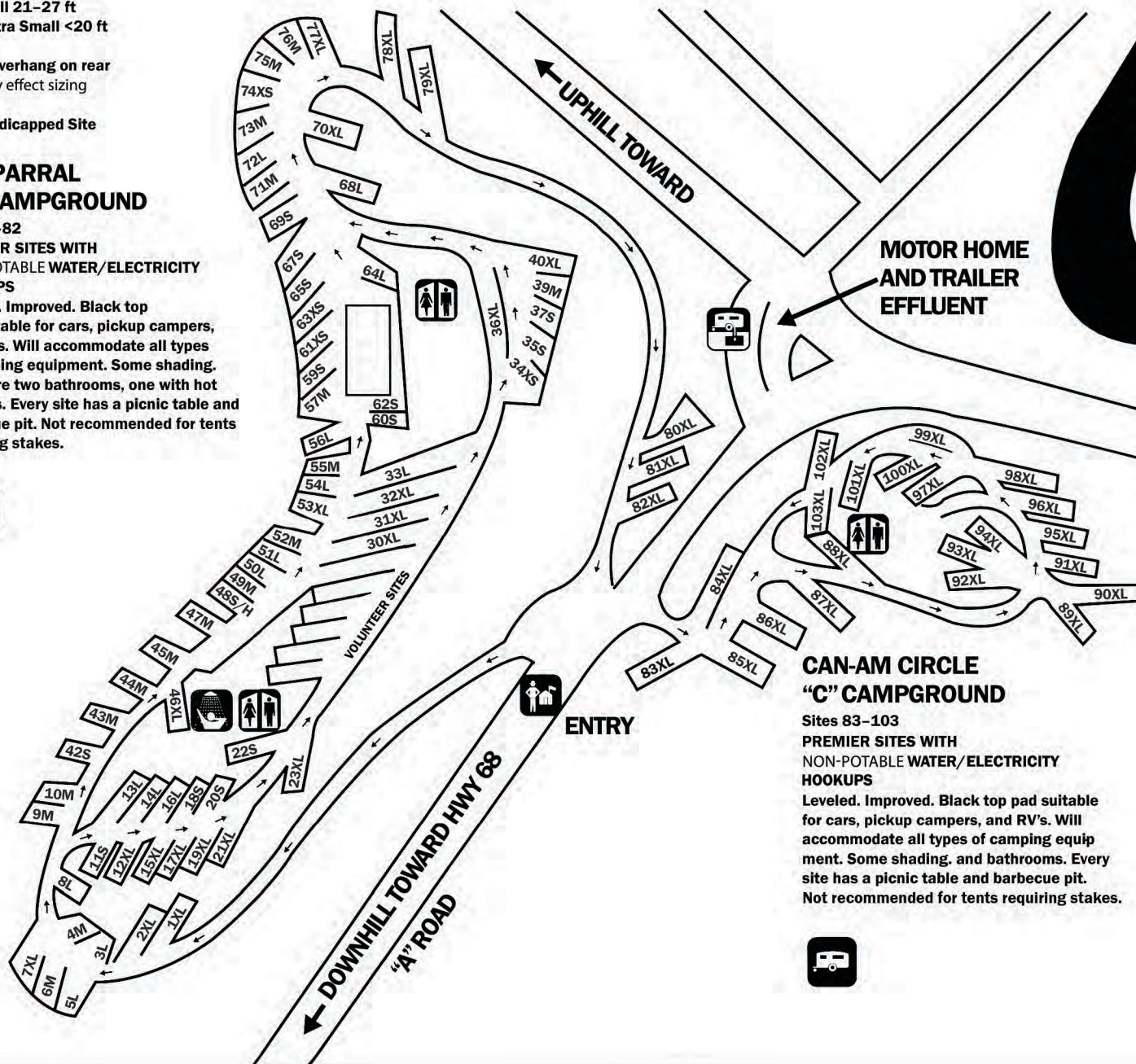
XL = Extra Large 39 ft+

### CHAPARRAL "B" CAMPGROUND

Sites 1-82  
**PREMIER SITES WITH NON-POTABLE WATER/ELECTRICITY HOOKUPS**  
 Leveled. Improved. Black top pad suitable for cars, pickup campers, and RV's. Will accommodate all types of camping equipment. Some shading. There are two bathrooms, one with hot showers. Every site has a picnic table and barbecue pit. Not recommended for tents requiring stakes.

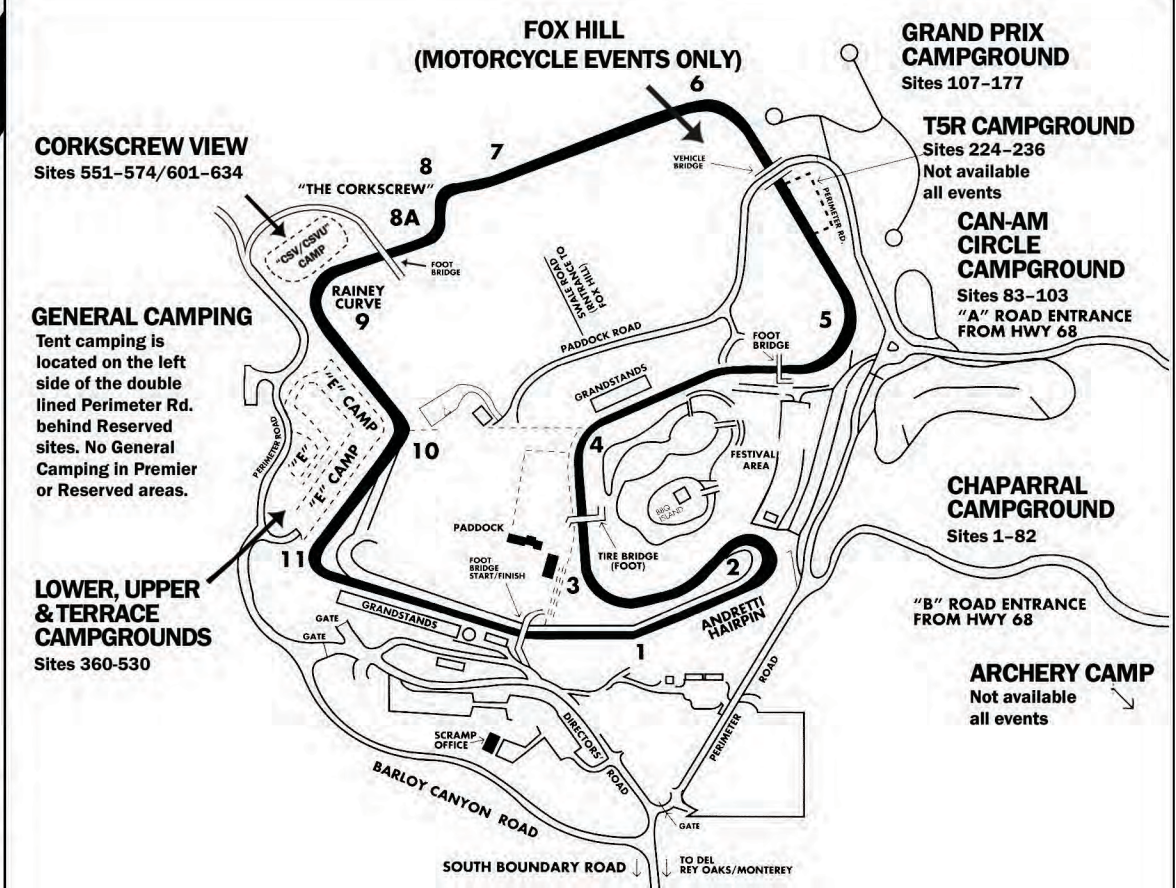


### CAN-AM CIRCLE "C" CAMPGROUND

Sites 83-103  
**PREMIER SITES WITH NON-POTABLE WATER/ELECTRICITY HOOKUPS**  
 Leveled. Improved. Black top pad suitable for cars, pickup campers, and RV's. Will accommodate all types of camping equipment. Some shading. and bathrooms. Every site has a picnic table and barbecue pit. Not recommended for tents requiring stakes.



**T5R CAMPGROUND**  
 Sites 224-236  
**PREMIER & RESERVED CAMPING. NO HOOKUPS** Semi-leveled. Dirt-top, suitable for tents & RVs. Showers within walking distance. No picnic tables or barbeque pits.



### GRAND PRIX "A" CAMPGROUND

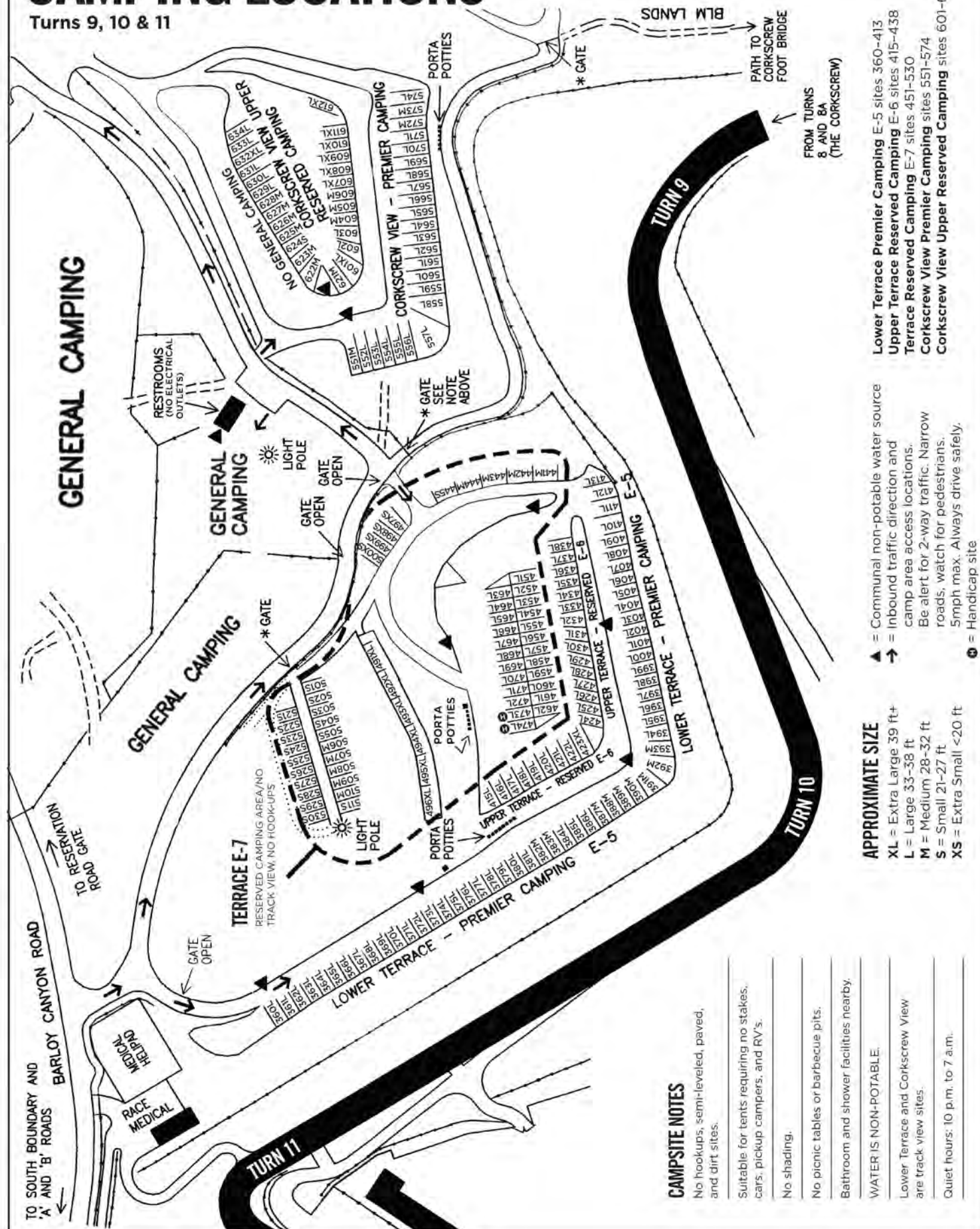
Sites 107-177  
**RESERVED SITES NO HOOKUPS**  
 Semi-Leveled. Dirt top, suitable for tents requiring stakes, cars, pickup campers, and RV's. Some shading. Hot showers within walking distance, playground, and periodic NON-POTABLE water points. Every site has a picnic table and barbecue pit.



**WATER POINTS**  
 WATER IS NON-POTABLE  
 Campers may fill water tanks but **must unhook** as this is community water.

### CAMPING NOTES

- No hookups, semi-leveled, paved, and dirt sites.
- Suitable for tents requiring no stakes, cars, pickup campers, and RV's.
- No shading.
- No picnic tables or barbecue pits.
- Bathroom and shower facilities nearby.
- WATER IS NON-POTABLE
- Lower Terrace and Corkscrew View are track view sites.
- Quiet hours: 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.

## INFORMATION FOR CAMPERS

Both camping and race tickets are required in order to camp at the facility. Campsite purchases DO NOT include race tickets nor does purchasing a race ticket include camping privileges, unless otherwise stated. All campers will be checked in and issued camping wristbands.

**Park/Track admittance** requires a race ticket for each visitor. Campers arriving prior to 4:00 p.m. must have race tickets for the current day plus ALL remaining days of the event. Admittance after 4:00 p.m. does not require tickets for the current day, but race tickets and a camping pass for ALL remaining days of the event are required.

The Main Gate is closed from Midnight to 7:00 A.M.

Quiet Hours are 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

All water sources/hookups have **NON-POTABLE** water. Campers are responsible for supplying their own drinking water.

Dumping grey water or waste onto the ground is prohibited. Dumping station is closed during events, but will re-open after the event ends.

Fires are permitted in designated campgrounds only and must be self contained. Fire rings are provided in campgrounds A (GRAND PRIX), B (CHAPARRAL) and C (CAN-AM CIRCLE). You may bring your own container (i.e. charcoal grill, hibachi, etc.) if your site is not equipped with a fire pit, but open fires are not permitted.

Picnic tables and fire pits must remain in their designated campsites.

## PREMIER CAMPING

- CHAPARRAL "B" Campground

- CORKSCREW VIEW "CSV" Campground

Premier Camping consists of a limited amount of assigned campsites. All sites in the Chaparral and Can-Am Circle areas have electricity (30 AMPS) and non-potable water hookups. All Lower Terrace, Corkscrew View and T5R campsites provide views of the track, but have no hookups. Premier Camping is sold for consecutive nights; the required length of stay may vary by event. Maximum of 8 people per site.

## RESERVED CAMPING

- GRAND PRIX "A" Campground
- UPPER TERRACE "E6" Campground
- TERRACE "E7" Campground
- CORKSCREW VIEW UPPER "CSVU" Campground

Reserved Camping consists of a limited number of assigned campsites and is sold for consecutive nights; the required length of stay may vary by event. Maximum of 8 people per site.

## GENERAL CAMPING

Sites are located on unimproved dirt areas.

Approximate size per General Camping site:  
RV: 10 x 40 square feet  
Tent: 20 x 20

Turn 9, 10, and 11: General tent camping (located on the left side of Perimeter Road behind Reserved campsites)

**Fox Hill:** Motorcycle access only. No vehicles, except motorcycles, will be permitted in the Fox Hill camping area. No additional support vehicles or parking available. Sold for motorcycle events only.

General Camping is sold on a consecutive night basis as follows:

- 4 NIGHTS: Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights
- 3 NIGHTS: Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights
- 2 NIGHTS: Friday and Saturday nights
- 1 NIGHT: Saturday night

Maximum of 4 people per site. No additional support vehicle passes can be purchased for General Camping Areas. General Camping must be purchased in advance to guarantee a site. Campsites are selected on a first come first serve basis upon arrival. Gates open at 10:00 am on the first day of event camping.

The Ticket Office will issue 1 camping/primary vehicle pass and 1 support vehicle pass per campsite. LSRA defines the primary vehicle as that which is used for sleeping during your stay (i.e. RV or trailer). In the case of tent camping, your tent takes the place of a primary vehicle. LSRA defines support vehicles as non-sleeping vehicles towing, being towed by or accompanying the primary vehicle. The primary purpose of a support vehicle is to provide transportation to and from the facility throughout the weekend. All vehicle passes are valid for 1 vehicle or 2 motorcycles (4 wheels total).

### Additional support vehicles

1 additional support vehicle pass may be purchased upon arrival, space permitting. All vehicles (primary and support) must fit within the campsite. No additional overnight parking will be provided.

Pets are allowed in the camping areas only and may not be left unattended. Dogs are to remain leashed and said leash may not exceed 6 feet in length. Pets are not allowed in the spectator areas, Paddock, grandstands, hillsides or Marketplace.

No Scaffolding or structures are to be erected within camping areas or on top of vehicles.

Standing or sitting on top of vehicles, that are not designed for such use, is prohibited.

Canopies may not be set up prior to the first day of the event's paid camping.

Sale of any product in designated camping areas is prohibited. Violators will be escorted from the facility and all product will be confiscated.

All signs, advertising products, or businesses must face away from the track and any facility roads. LSRA reserves the right to remove any signs that are deemed offensive or represent a conflict of interest.

Absolutely NO firearms, fireworks, drones or weapons of any kind are allowed at WeatherTech Raceway Laguna Seca.

Marked fire lanes must be kept clear at all times. Violators will be towed at owner's expense.

Absolutely no admittance to the track side of the spectator fences.

Keep your vehicles locked and valuables out of site. Do not leave property out at night or unattended at any time. LSRA and the County of Monterey are not responsible for nor assumes any liability arising from theft, fire, damage to or lost property (including vehicles).

Licensed vehicles (golf cart, utility vehicles, etc.) being driven on roadways must be registered with the Event Operations Department.

No off-road vehicles (ATV's, powered scooters, etc.)

Bicycles are permitted on paved roads only. Bicycle riders assume the risk of injury to himself/herself and/or any damages to property and agree to waive any claim against LSRA Management and Monterey County.

The California Helmet Law is enforced on all WeatherTech Raceway Laguna Seca Roads.

No refunds or exchanges. In the event of a race postponement, camping passes and race tickets will be honored for the rescheduled race date (to be decided by the event promoter). WeatherTech Raceway (LSRA) is NOT responsible for lost, stolen, destroyed or forgotten tickets, parking or camping passes.

**Ticket Resale:** Ticket If your Race Ticket, Camping Ticket and/or Support Vehicle Pass is being sold on a secondary market (i.e. eBay, Craigslist, etc.) for more than the original purchase price, your renewal will be revoked without notification.

Roads and paths throughout the facility's 500 plus acres may contain obstructions such as, but not limited to, potholes and uneven pavement. You agree that neither LSRA Management nor Monterey County are liable for any injury or property damage that occur within the Laguna Seca Recreation Area and assume the risk and waive any claim for injury or property damage while on Laguna Seca premises.
