## Purpose

It is the policy of the Behavioral Health Division to perform a compliance review for the safety and effectiveness of medication practices for narcotic treatment programs (NTP) and Drug Medical Organized Delivery System (DMC- ODS) residential treatment services.

## Policy

For NTP, the following areas of medication practices shall be reviewed:

- 1. Organizational policy on medication practices
- 2. Evidence of staff training on medication practices
- 3. Procedure for ordering narcotic medications
- 4. Procedure for receiving narcotic medications
- 5. Procedure for dispensing and administering medication
- 6. Upkeep and adequacy of equipment used in dispensing medication
- 7. Record keeping for dispensing medication
- 8. Security of controlled substance stocks
- 9. Procedure for unsupervised use (take-home) medication

For DMC ODS Residential Programs, the following areas of medication practices shall be reviewed:

- 1. Organizational policy on medication practices
- 2. Evidence of training on medication practices
- 3. Procedure on the receipt and storage of medications
- 4. General procedure for access and consumption of medication
- 5. Specific procedure for access and consumption of controlled substances
- 6. General procedure or disposal of medication

7. Specific procedure or disposal of controlled substances

- 1. Medication practice compliance reviews will occur on an annual basis
- 2. Reviews will be performed by the Medical Director's designee
- 3. Reviews for NTP and residential facilities will occur on-site and use the attached tools
- 4. Staff will be trained in the use of medication practice compliance tools
  - 5. Feedback will be given to programs in person at end of visit and in a written within a week of the review
- 6. Programs are expected to comply with any corrective action and show evidence of improvement in cited areas
  - 7. Corrective action plan may call for more frequent compliance reviews
