They currently provide emergency shelter for women and children, emergency shelter for single men or women, street outreach, transitional housing for men, women and families and supportive services and case management. They have 123 beds available for domestic violence victims; 16 in Seaside, 32 in Salinas and 75 in Marina. He is also looking into opening 12 more beds in Monterey and possibly 6 more in Marina. Currently the programs are seeing many more people with mental health needs and thus he is trying to have more clinicians on site to deal with those concerns.
